Number of foreign students in schools

In the school year 2009/2010 there was 60 721 foreign students in the Czech Republic and this number includes all types of schools. Total number of all pupils and students in the Czech Republic was 2 086 163 (including citizens of the Czech Republic), foreigners accounted for 2.9% of them.

Number of children with foreign nationalities at individual school levels during the school year 2009/2010

Preschools

3963 foreigners (1,3%) out of total number of 314 008 children.

Out of them number 1040 is EU citizens (0.3%) and 55 asylum seekers.

There is 91.8% of children of parents with permanent residence.

Primary schools

13 839 foreigners (1,7%) out of total number of 794 459 children.

Out of them number 3 781 is EU citizens (0,5%) and 438 asylum seekers.

There is 81,9% of children of parents with permanent residence.

High schools

7 900 foreigners (1,4%) out of total number of 556 260 students.

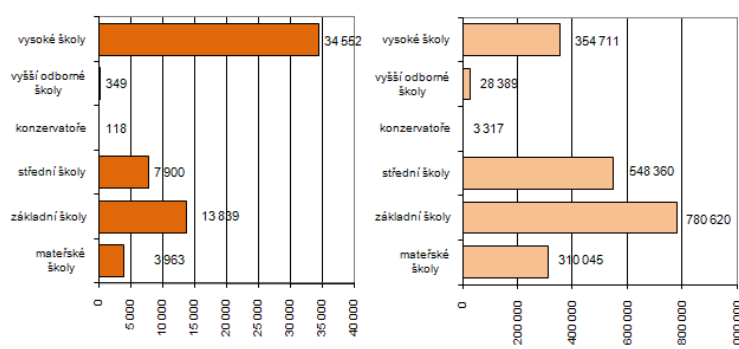
Out of them 1 914 is EU citizens (0,3%) and 63 asylum seekers.

Students of foreign nationals with permanent residence is 83.7%.

Universities

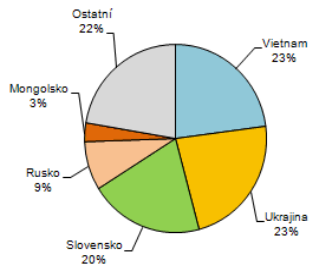
34 552 foreigners (8,9%) out of total number of 389 231 students.

Number of foreign students in various types of schools 2009/2010 Number of Czech students in various type of schools 2009/2010



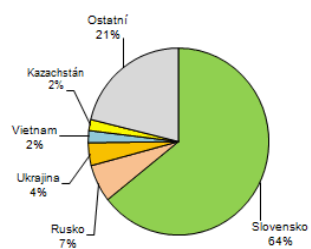
Foreigners in primary schools in the CR
