The Dyslang consortium benefits greatly from the presence of Associated Partners. These are organisations whose knowledge, facilities and networks are able to enhance the quality of the project's work. A number of these Associated Partners have been actively involved in different aspects of the Dyslang project through meetings, events, or delivering informational and promotional materials.

In several partner countries, Associated Partners took part in assisting with the delivery of the Needs Analysis Questionnaire and the collection of feedback. For example, the Regional Educational Inspectorate in Ruse supported the Bulgarian partner to carry out the questionnaire.

The Welsh partner contacted one of their Associated Partners (Newport Education Authority) who facilitated discussions with the head of the Gwent Education Multi-Ethnic Service who agreed to distribute information on the Needs Analysis amongst teachers and who also offered insight into the needs of multilingual families in the Gwent region. The Czech partner has worked closely with one of their Associated Partners (the DYS-centre in Prague) to explore the possibility of national accreditation of the Dyslang course.
